WHEREAS: The MES Bylaws must be updated and organized to represent the current structure and operations of the MES.

BIRT: Remove Academic Resources Coordinator, change any mentions of it to AVP AR

BIFRT: The Administrator shall be responsible for sending out MES Council meeting agendas ahead of meetings as well as ensure the posting of meeting minutes on the website

BIFRT: Remove the \$1500 MES exec collateral deposit for Exec transition

BIFRT: Remove specific mention of SRA Engineering Caucus rights at MES council meeting

BIFRT: Remove the Faculty Committees section and specify in the descriptions of each position the committees that they sit on

BIFRT: Runner-up candidates for by-elections no longer automatically get the position if the winning candidate refuses the position

- Proposal: Integrating usage of platforms, ie, using avenue to post pictures rather than crowdmark. Creating a 'course google calendar' to help manage time much better in terms of deadlines whatnot
 - There are things we can and cannot necessarily advocate
