- Presentation now also includes additions to reflect financial aid as a factor of MES membership
- Drain employees are no longer required to apply as MES members, but must be members after employment
- This was already discussed just put in writing
- Many clerical changes

- How will the cooc's be able to provide these exceptions?
 - It is up to their discretion based on an application-based appeal.
 - To clarify, this does not count as an actual membership rather than being allowed to participate despite not being a member
 - This will not be a written record, which is why the criteria is not completely clear
 - The year such that a student is selected will be the year that a rep will be exempted from MES membership. This should be clarified.
